



"Dyslexia in schools - see the bigger picture" by Susanna Cederquist

Dyslexia means reading and writing difficulties but also access to specific strengths. In this book, *Susanna Cederquist* describes why it is important to see the whole picture of dyslexia - to work with both the strengths and weaknesses and give students the tools they need. The idea of *Dyslexia in school - see the bigger picture* is to show how dyslexics can experience different situations in the classroom. The book is about how we can create an equivalent education for students with dyslexia.

The book therefore largely consists of case descriptions, short stories of different situations that dyslexics may end up in. In connection with these descriptions, the author gives advice on how you as a teacher can act and think. *Dyslexia in school - see the bigger picture* is aimed primarily at teachers in all subjects, from preschool to high school, but also school leaders and other staff who can benefit from the book to increase their understanding of dyslexia.

Susanna Cederquist is a teacher and has been spending 15 years changing and broadening the view of dyslexia in Sweden. She lectures and is an advisor on matters concerning the concept of accessible education. Susanna has extensive experience of close collaboration with international researchers and dyslexia experts around the world.
